

Compliance FAQ

I am a radio product supplier, what do I need to do?

1. Ensure product operates in accordance with licensing policy in New Zealand – see the [Table of Radio Spectrum Usage in New Zealand](#), the [licensing information](#) page, and the [Radiocommunications Regulations \(General User Radio Licence for Short Range Devices\) Notice 2003](#).
2. [Ensure product complies with an applicable standard](#)
3. Determine compliance level (see right hand column of the table)
4. [Ensure requirements for the compliance level are met](#)

You should ensure you understand the requirements in the Radiocommunications (Compliance) Notice 2004 and Radiocommunications (Radio Standards) Notice 2004

I am an electrical product supplier, what do I need to do?

1. [Ensure product complies with an applicable standard](#)
2. [Determine compliance level \(see points 6, 7 and 8\)](#)
3. [Ensure requirements for the compliance level are met](#)
