**TERMS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS APPLYING TO
MARITIME RADIO LICENCES
(COAST)**

1. The radio licence permits the use of radio apparatus for the conduct of radiocommunication in the "Maritime Mobile Service" defined in the International Radio Regulations as "A mobile service between coast stations and ship stations, or between ship stations, or between associated on-board communication stations; survival craft stations and emergency position indicating radio beacon stations may also participate in this service".
2. Except in emergencies, the maritime (Coast) radio apparatus to which the radio licence relates, shall not communicate with any other land base radio apparatus.
3. If 2182 kHz is fitted, the operator of the apparatus shall, during hours of service, keep watch on 2182 kHz for 3 minutes commencing on the hour and on the half-hour. During these periods all transmissions between the frequencies of 2173.5 and 2190.5 kHz, except for distress, urgency or safety transmissions, must cease.
