This paper seeks agreement to a process for implementing agreed policy on expiry of commercial radio spectrum rights. It then applies the process to spectrum rights used for UHF television and spectrum rights in the 2.3GHz spectrum band. [Published 01 December 2004].

This paper recommends adoption of a price-setting formula for the renewal of commercial spectrum rights, release of a discussion paper as a basis for further consultation with industry, and agreement on policy proposals for dealing with non-commercial spectrum rights when they expire [Published 1 May 2004].

This paper recommends that interim decisions on the policy for the reallocation of commercial spectrum rights established under the Radiocommunications Act 1989 ("the Act") and expiring from 2010 be confirmed. [Published 12 May 2003].
