

# RADIO SPECTRUM MANAGEMENT



## Annual licence fees

Fees are collected by Radio Spectrum Management (RSM) to recover the cost of providing services. The objective is to:

- Continually seek to improve efficiency in the administration of the Act
- Fully recover the costs associated with administering the Act
- Fairly allocate the costs in relation to work undertaken

Annual licence fees can be paid online in the Register of Radio Frequencies (the Register). Read more about how to [pay for annual licence fees](#).

A manual payment fee of \$25 will be added to any payment made by cash, cheque, or any other kind of payment other than an electronic payment or any payment by credit card.
